Dear Briggsville Water District Customer,

The Briggsville Water District is required to develop a Service Line Inventory and is working with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) to develop a Service Line Inventory which consists of the verification of each service line material. As part of the inventory process the Briggsville Water District wants to assist its customers to identify the material of the service lines providing them water.

What Action Can You Take?

The Massachusetts Lead Service Line Identification (MA-LSLI) Web App, a tool developed by MassDEP for homeowners, is a questionnaire for customers with an option to submit a photo of your service line. Briggsville will compile this unique data to complete the Service Line Inventory a state and federal requirement.

How does the Lead Service Line Identification (MA-LSLI) Web App work?



- Locate the form at https://app.smartsheet.com/b/form/f9ee39b7972f443ca63e8b936cd7f92b or using the QR code.
- Complete all the questions and select "Briggsville Water District (PWS ID 1063003)" as your water supplier. The form is compatible with both traditional desktop web browsers and mobile browsers. The form asks for basic user information and to upload one or more photos of the Service Line that connects to your water meter the pipe that enters your house and joins the water meter. The EPA service line identification guide https://www.epa.gov/ground-water-and-drinking-water/protect-your-tap-quick-check-lead-0 "Protect Your Tap: A Quick Check for Lead," may be used to help you identify your service line material, if unknown.
- Your collaboration is crucial because the Service Line comes to your water shut-off, which is located inside your property, and no one except you has access to it. Please either scan the QR code or go to the first link above and complete the questionnaire.
